



Proposed Policy on LGBTQ+ Rights

JCRB|AJC has proudly advocated for LGBTQ+ issues since the 1980s. Judaism teaches that every human being is made “B’tselem Elohim” – in the image of G-d. We therefore fully and unequivocally respect and support the full rights of all people, regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity, or any other identity.

Discriminating against categories of people is unacceptable. We oppose invoking religious based arguments that would allow such discrimination.

We also recognize and further condemn the disproportionate targeting of LGBTQ+ people of color by violence or discrimination.
